## SNOWMAN POPCORN CUPS



## Materials

14oz Clear Plastic Cups
Construction Paper
Variety of Holiday Ribbon
Permanent Markers
Scissors
Glue
Pony Beads (optional)
Popcorn

## Directions

1. Use scissors to cut out construction paper snowman shapes. This could include a nose, eyes, buttons, etc.
2. Use glue to paste construction paper shapes on cup.
3. Add additional shapes using permanent marker.
4. Cut ribbon and tie around cup to add a scarf.
5. Add popcorn.

## Hints and Extended Learning Opportunities

- Estimate the number of kernels of popcorn it takes to fill a cup.
- Use popcorn kernels from the cup to create letter shapes and practice phonetic sounds.
- Read as a group, The Snowy Day by Ezra Keats.
- For younger children, offer pre-cut construction paper snowman pieces and promote fine motor skills by having them use a cotton swab to apply glue and attach pieces to their cup.
- For older children, allow them to practice using scissors to curl ribbon pieces.
