

THANKFUL TREE CENTERPIECE



Materials

Colored Paper

Markers or Pens

Sticks

Vase or Glass Jar

Acorns or Marbles

Hole Puncher

Yarn or Twine

Directions

1. Go on a nature walk to collect a variety of sticks.
2. Cut leaf shapes out of different colored paper. You can also cut them out of white paper and color them with markers or crayons.
3. Have each child write what they are thankful for on one of the leaves.
4. Punch a hole at the top of the leaves. Cut the yarn or twine into 4-5" pieces and string through the leaves.
5. Place acorns or marbles into your vase or glass jar. Add the sticks and space out evenly.
6. Using the yarn or twine, attach the leaves to the sticks.
7. Display your beautiful centerpiece on the table.
