Providers without a tier status are treated as Tier II for the purposes of claims processing. Each month, My Food Program will determine if a provider is Tier II High, Tier II Mixed or Tier II Low for the claim month. Tier II High means all children are eligible for Tier I reimbursement even though the home is not located in a geographic area designated as low-income by the USDA. Tier II Mixed means that some children are eligible for Tier I reimbursement even though the home is not located in a geographic area designated as low-income by the USDA. Tier II Low means that all children are eligible for Tier II reimbursement.
