

## JUNETEENTH FLAG SUN CATCHER



## Materials

Contact Paper

Double-Sided Tape

Red, Black, and Green Tissue Paper

Scissors

3 Bowls

## Directions

- 1. Cut approximately one inch squares of red, black, and green tissue paper and place the squares into bowls divided by color.
- 2. Cut a rectangle shape out of contact paper and secure it to a window using double-sided tape, sticky side of contact paper facing out.
- 3. Attach tissue paper squares to the contact paper to create the Pan-African flag.

## Hints and Extended Learning Opportunities

- For younger children, cut squares of tissue paper ahead of time and draw lines on the flag so they know where to place each color of tissue paper.
- Read as a group, Juneteenth for Mazie by Floyd Cooper.
- Host a Juneteenth Jamboree or Festival of Freedom.
- Watch Sesame Street: Celebrate Juneteenth Song
