

## OPTION 1

1. Send your claim data directly to QuickBooks.
2. Pay bills in QuickBooks using linked ACH software.

### Notes:

- All provider or center bank account information will be stored in your ACH software.
- There are many [apps](#) that you can use to make payments from QuickBooks. Some of them are free and all of them meet stringent financial security requirements.
- This option requires that your providers or centers are listed as vendors in QuickBooks - you can import them easily.
- This option does NOT involve downloading and uploading files – there is a direct connection between My Food Program, QuickBooks and your ACH software.

## OPTION 2

1. Download your claim data from My Food Program and into an Excel file.
2. Upload that file into an ACH creation software program.
3. The ACH creation software will be linked with your bank.

### Notes:

- All provider or center bank account information will be stored in your ACH software.
- There is an additional fee for ACH software. Some affordable options include:
  - [Treasury Software](#): \$20 per month with no other fees
  - [ezACH Deposit Software](#): One-time fee of \$199 (no monthly fee)
  - [ACH Payments Creator](#): One-time fee of \$99 (no monthly fee)
- This option does not link to your accounting software, so you'll need to record a bill or expense.
- This option involves downloading and uploading files – there is no direct connection between My Food Program and the ACH software.
