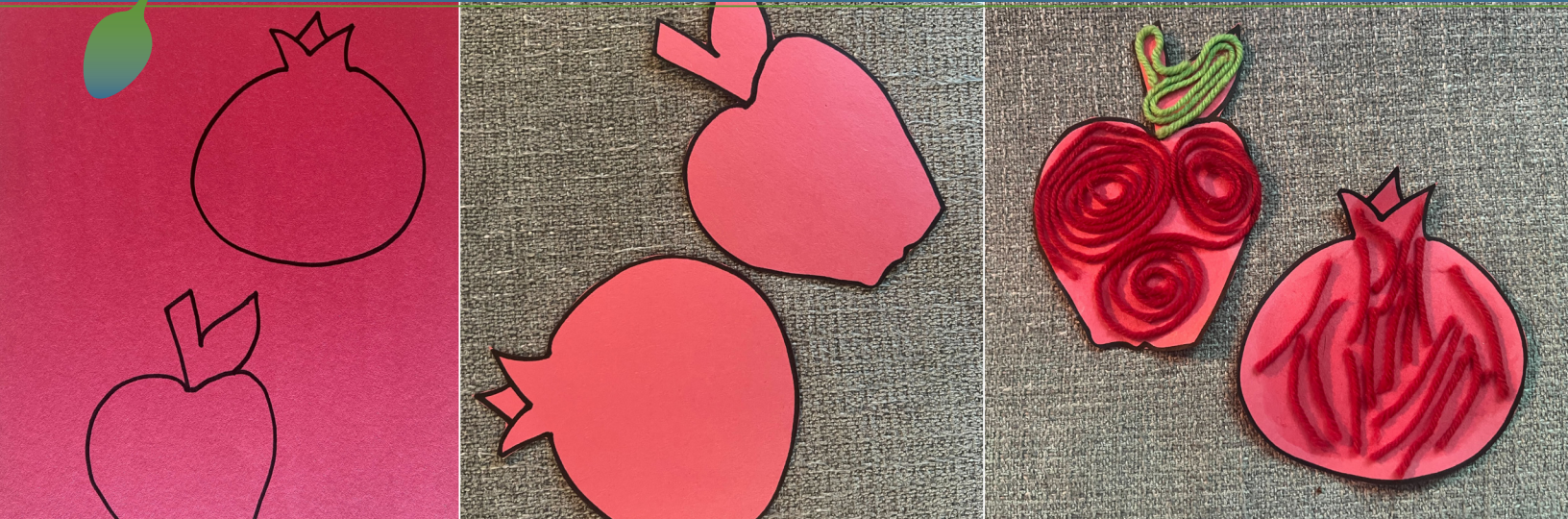


ROSH HASHANAH YARN ART



Materials

Red Construction Paper
Red and Green Yarn
Black Marker
Scissors
School Glue
Cotton Swabs

Directions

1. Use the black marker to draw the outline of an apple and a pomegranate on red construction paper.
2. Use scissors to cut out the outline of the shapes.
3. Apply glue to the front of the shape using a cotton swab to evenly cover the surface.
4. Press red and green yarn onto the shapes to create a design.

Hints and Extended Learning Opportunities

- For younger children, provide precut apple and pomegranate shapes and precut pieces of yarn.
- Read as a group, *Once Upon an Apple Cake: A Rosh Hashanah Story* by Elana Rubinstein.
- Have children create Shana Tova Cards and send out cards to family and friends wishing them a sweet new year.
