



ROSH HASHANAH YARN ART







Materials

Red Construction Paper
Red and Green Yarn
Black Marker
Scissors
School Glue
Cotton Swabs

Directions

- 1. Use the black marker to draw the outline of an apple and a pomegranate on red construction paper.
- 2. Use scissors to cut out the outline of the shapes.
- 3. Apply glue to the front of the shape using a cotton swab to evenly cover the surface.
- 4. Press red and green yarn onto the shapes to create a design.

Hints and Extended Learning Opportunities

- For younger children, provide precut apple and pomegranate shapes and precut pieces of yarn.
- Read as a group, Once Upon an Apple Cake: A Rosh Hashanah Story by Elana Rubinstein.
- Have children create Shana Tova Cards and send out cards to family and friends wishing them a sweet new year.

- Slice apples and dip them in honey as a snack to celebrate.
