

HALLOWEEN HANDPRINT FRIENDS



Materials

Black, Green, White and Orange Construction Paper

Black Marker

Scissors

Glue

Directions

- 1. Use the black marker to trace children's handprints onto the orange, white, green and black construction paper.
- 2. Use scissors to cut out handprints.
- 3. Use the black marker to create a face on the orange handprint to create a pumpkin, add a stem and leaves.
- 4. Use the black marker to create a face on the white handprint to make a ghost.
- 5. Use the black marker to create a face on the green handprint to create Frankenstein.
- 6. Cut the fingers of the black handprint and glue on top of the green handprint to create Frankenstein's hair.

Hints and Extended Learning Opportunities

- For younger children, promote fine motor sills by having them use a cotton swab dipped in glue to apply pre-cut pieces to the paper plate.
- Read as a group, *Too Many Pumpkins* by Linda White.
- Downloand and complete our <u>Halloween Search and Find</u>.
- Play a game of Halloween charades.
- Toast pumpkin seeds for snacks.
