

GALAXY SNOW GLOBES



Materials

Snow Globe or Small Plastic Mason Jars

Distilled Water

Food Coloring

Silver Glitter

Silver Star Confetti

Baby Oil

Directions

- 1. Add some food coloring to water to get desired color.
- 2. Fill snow globe or jar half way with baby oil.
- 3. Add some glitter and stars.
- 4. Fill the globe the rest of the way with colored water.
- 5. Leave room to close the lid.

Hints and Extended Learning Opportunities

- For younger children, assist them in the pouring of the liquid .
- Play the ice skating FREEZE game. Have children use paper plates as ice skates and place one under each foot. Slide around the room to music and freeze when the music stops.
- Create a winter snow sensory bin or table. Use cotton balls to represent snow. Add foam snowflakes and snowmen along with tools for scooping the snow.
- As a group read *Snowy Day* by Anabel Soto and Jillian Dister.
- Create shaving cream snowmen on the table top.
- Dance and move to <u>Wintertime is Here.</u>
